






How can you fit Study Abroad into your linguistics major?

Linguistics majors take 12 upper-division linguistics classes, and must satisfy a Language Proficiency Requirement

Study Abroad can easily be integrated into such a program; a maximum of 6 (4 credit) study abroad courses or equivalent can be counted towards the major. We recommend focusing on Linguistics elective courses while abroad

Here is a sample template for study abroad in junior year for a General Linguistics major:
